



## HOT DOG PILLOW CASES

### **Fabric Pieces Needed:**

WOF = width of fabric (42"-44")

**TRIM:** (1) - 2" strip WOF folded and pressed in half lengthwise (wrong sides together).

**CUFF:** (1) - 9" strip WOF

**BODY:** (1) - 27" strip WOF

Baby Size: Body: 16" x 26"

Cuff: 6" x 26"

Trim: 1 3/4" x 26"

**Step 1:** Lay the folded and pressed **trim** piece on top of the **cuff** piece right side up. **Pin in place.**

**Step 2:** Place the **body** piece right side down on top of the pinned pieces above. **Pin in place.** Stitch 1/4" from raw edges. \*At this stage you might want to trim the sides to even the 3 layers.

**Step 3:** Roll body piece to the sewn edge but out of the way of the seam. Bring the cuff piece (wrong side out) around the body. Turn the whole unit over and **pin.** Sew to the left of the first stitching.

**Step 4:** Pull the hot dog (body) out of the "bun" (cuff). Press.

**Step 5:** Put **wrong** sides together and stitch 1/4" seam across the bottom and open side.

**Step 6:** Turn wrong side out (right sides together) and restitch the bottom & side using 1/2" seam.

**Step 7:** Turn right sides out and press. You just made a "Hot Dog Pillow Case."
